## Job Van Uitert Wins Race 1 at Adria ahead of Lorenzo Colombo and Marcus Armstrong.

Rookie Trophy Leonardo Lorandi took the win, second was Enzo Fittipaldi with Giorgio Carrara in third. Sophia Floersch won the Women's Trophy.

Adria (Rovigo) 6/5/2017 – Race 1 of the Italian F.4 Championship powered by Abarth started in heavy rain behind the Safety Car, which entered into pitlane after 3 laps. The treacherous conditions meant that drivers did not risk too much in the opening laps. With one following another, the Dutchman Job Van Uitert (Jenzer Motorsport), who demonstrated his pace immediately and by the 12th lap he was leading the race, thanks to a great pass on the Italian Lorenzo Colombo (Bhaitech) who himself would finish in second. On the third step of the podium was the New Zealander Marcus Armstrong driving for the Prema Power Team.

- Fourth place went to the Indian driver Kush Maini (Jenzer Motorsport), ahead of the first of the Rookies, the Italian Leonardo Lorandi (Bhaitech). Behind him was the next of the Rookies: the Brazilian Enzo Fittipaldi (Prema Power Team). Seventh place and first in the Women's Trophy was the German Sophia Floersch (BWT Mucke Motorsport), followed by the Guatemalan Ian Rodriguez (DRZ Benelli), the Argentine Giorgio Carrara (third of the Rookies) and the third of the Rookies Giacomo Bianchi, the Swiss driver with Jenzer Motorsport.

- In the Rookie Trophy, behind Lorandi, Fittipaldi and Carrara was the Brazilian Felipe Branquinho (DR Formula) and the French driver Alessandro Ghiretti (BDL Motorsport).
- Tomorrow, Sunday May 7, at 9:40 and 15:30 will be races 2 and 3, both over a distance of 28 minutes + 1 lap.
